Jenny Schu has been beading for over 20 years and weaving for 15 years, developing various fiber techniques along the way. She earned a Bachelors of Fine Arts with a concentration in Fiber Art and a Minor in Art History from the University of Michigan in 2004. Since then her beaded jewelry has been in numerous galleries, has been exhibited nationally, has been awarded grants and received numerous awards from the Michigan League of Handweavers, and has been an Instructor of Visual Arts at Interlochen College of Creative Arts. In March of 2019, Jenny presented "Handweaving and Beading" to our guild.

Jenny uses the St. Petersburg Chain Stitch as the edging on her weavings, bracelets, necklaces and even portions of earrings. This workshop will focus on the basics of learning the St. Petersburg Chain Stitch. Students can usually finish a bracelet length chain in a half day class with 11/0 beads. Jenny uses 15/0 beads (smaller) for much of her work but the smaller beads take a lot longer. Students are encouraged to start with 11/0 seed beads. Jenny will have some smaller beads for purchase if students are interested in trying a different size bead.

Supply List:

Extra Needles
11/0 Seed Beads
8/0 Seed Beads (larger for the middle)
Clasp (or a larger pearl 8mm or more
button for closure)
Whatever you bead on
(mat, velvet, trays)

Small notebook
